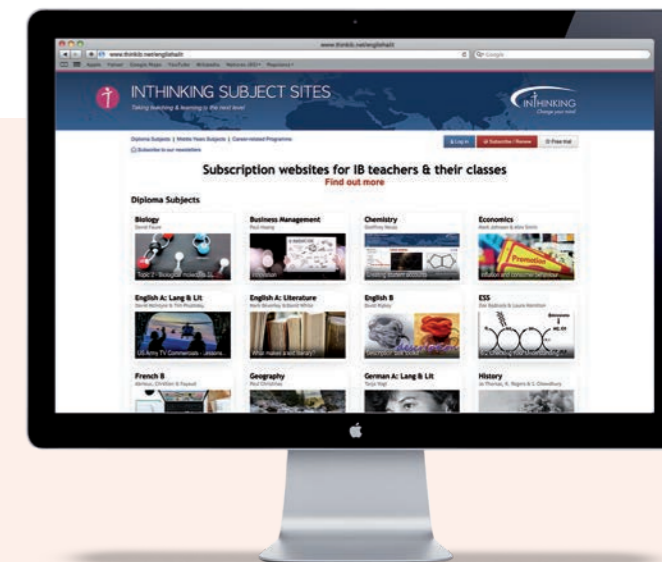

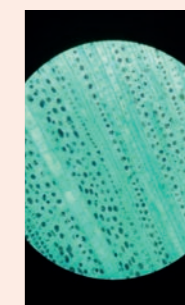
CELLS: ACTIVITIES FOR LEARNING

MEMBRANE TRANSPORT MODELS

Students are challenged to illustrate the transport of four very different molecules through the membrane using modelling clay, spaghetti, food and sweets. Protein pumps, protein channels, and the phospholipid bilayer are central to the story.



EVOLUTION EXAMPLES

Students investigate adaptive radiation and industrial melanism as well as gradual divergence of populations into separate species. All of these ideas have been contested by some groups so IB students should give them close scrutiny to see if the biological explanations are convincing.

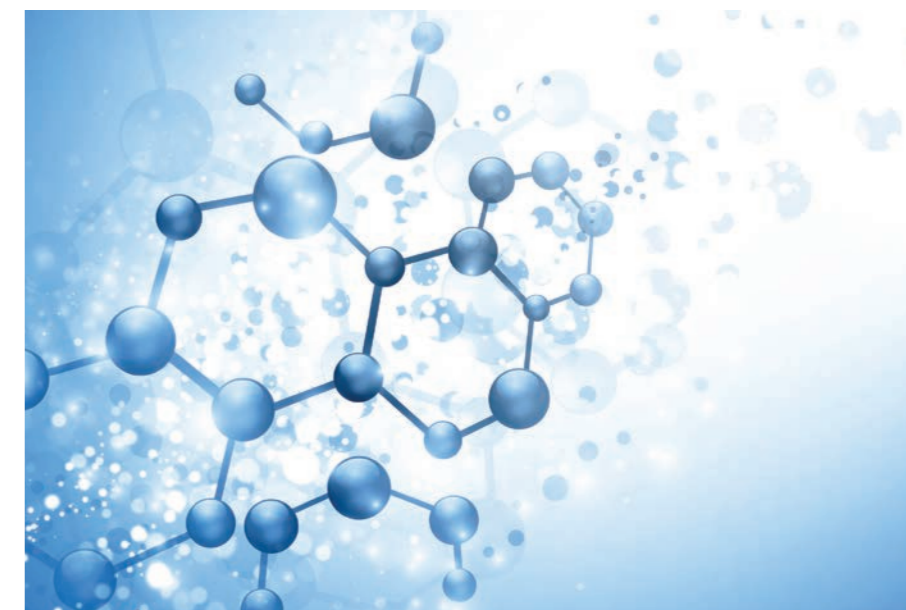

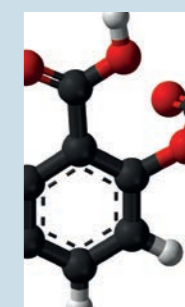
SCAFFOLDING THE INVESTIGATION

ANALYSIS OF ASPIRIN TABLETS

This practical enables students to determine the percentage of aspirin in various brands of locally available aspirin tablets. They can then work out the cost per gram of aspirin.
