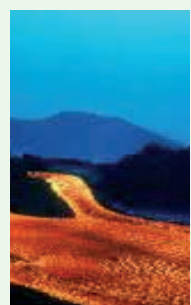

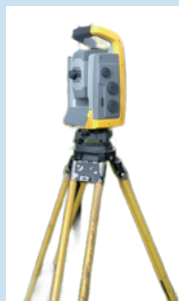
SIMILAR TRIANGLES

This section provides engaging and rigorous activities that cover all the trigonometry IGCSE content.



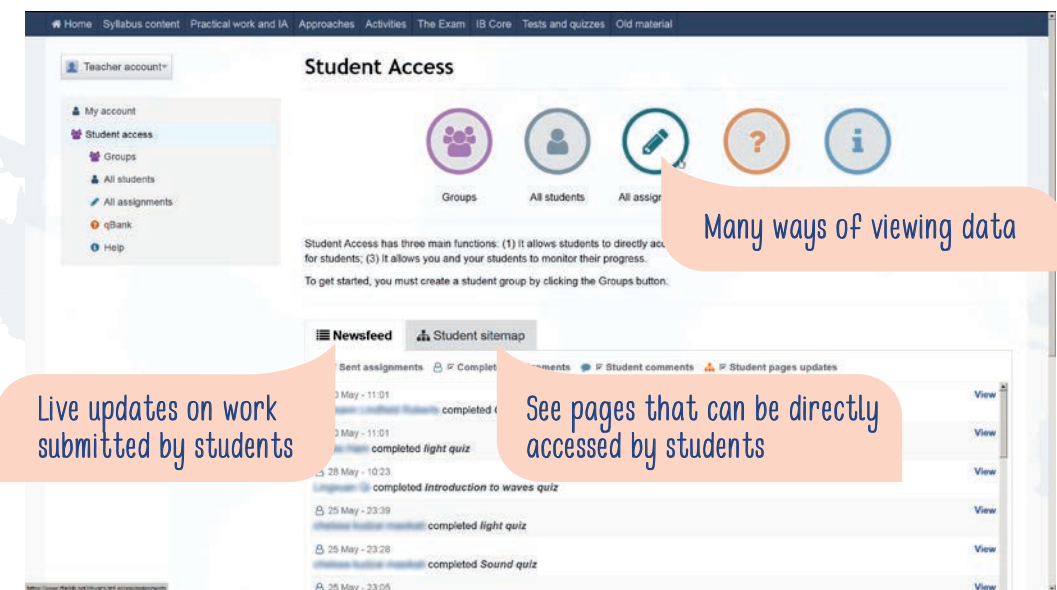
CONSTRUCTING QUADRILATERALS

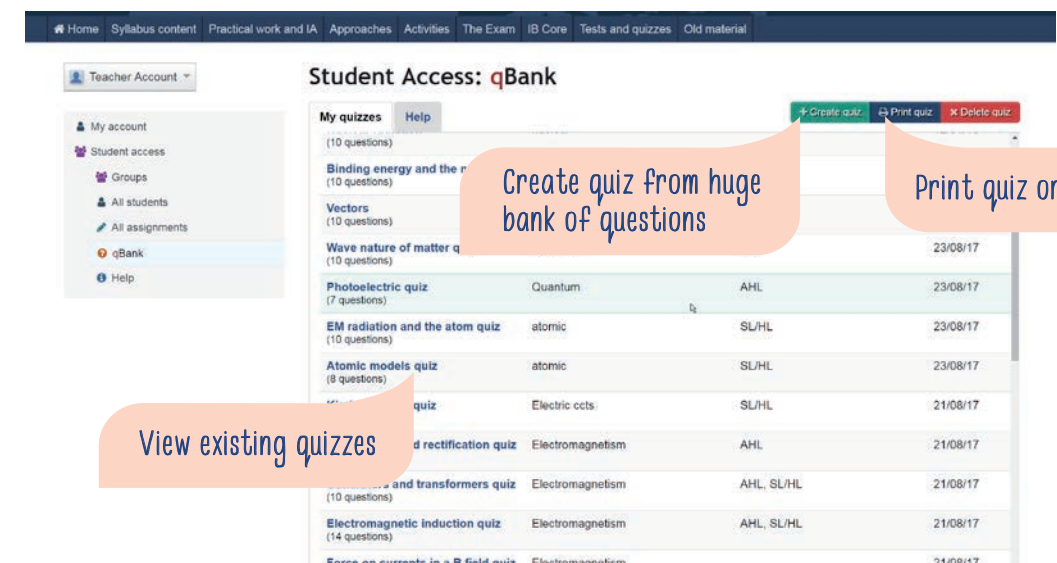
